Description & Call for Participation

The aim of this half-day workshop is to invite all stakeholders (*i.e.*, large organizations, tool providers and academics) involved in on-going R&D EU projects to disseminate their current challenges and on-going activities regarding visualization for DevOps environments. This call for participation is broadcasted in the following three project consortia: [ITEA Testomat](#), [Celtic-Next IoD](#), and [ITEA Visdom](#) (however, please feel free to disseminate this call for participation to whomever would be interested in participating, however please note that seats are limited and therefore the contributors to these three projects will be prioritized).

We invite participants to contribute, either with a short (up to 10 minutes), or a long (up to 20 minutes) presentations, and encompassing, e.g., the following topics:

- Current challenges from end-user perspectives in large organizations for collecting and visualizing DevOps data and meta-data across business units / data silos & repositories / Development & Operational phases, end-to-end continuous feedback loops, etc.,
- Innovative tool presentations and/or demos related to, e.g., cross-silo data consumption, aggregation, storage, monitoring, visualization and/or data analysis & diagnostic,
- Research tool presentations or demos focused on bespoke visualization, e.g., related to testing phases, dependency analysis, runtime monitoring, etc.,
- Outcomes of technological watching from the market about off-the-shelf DevOps visualization tools & platforms, open-source stacks, or visualization libraries used in your projects, products, or industrial development tool-chains,
- Definition of ontological models for DevOps metrics and KPIs.
